*Just an update letting you know Helen's condition. She remains in ICU in a stable condition having had surgery to her face yesterday and hip and pelvic surgery the day before. She has many cuts and bruises but all these will heal. She is much better today and is improving daily. She is starting to get cheeky and bored so must be on the mend. I would like to thank you all for your prayers and support. It is only the prayers of the Lord's people that has brought her through. It was potentially life threatening but the hospital here is fantastic.*

*At this stage she does not need any further surgery so we have a possible 5-6 week recovery period here before she would be fit enough to travel. Give my regards to everyone.*
